

Dazzling finale to Miss & Mr Teen contest

IN THE Miss & Mr Teen India 2003 contest held recently at Air Force Auditorium, Subroto Park, Aashima Sethi was selected Miss Teen India 2003 while Aditya Chawla walked away with Mr Teen India 2003 title.

The event was organised by Alee Club, a voluntary organisation devoted to the cause of eradicating social ills. The contest comprised an IQ test, questions on the awareness of HIV/AIDS and ramp walk.

The programme took off with lighting of the lamp by actress Sushma Seth. Actor Amrish Puri was the chief guest.

In the first round, the ethnic round, contestants walked the ramp in traditional costumes on a beautifully decorated stage that had a touch of the Moghul period.
